RE: RFP #3-10 – Communication Tower Surveying Addendum # 2

Questions posed to our consultant regarding the Survey RFP #3-10 and his answers (in bold):

- 1) Under the fourth paragraph of the Specifications there is a request for location “both within the planned parcel and surrounding parcel”. Can you define the “surrounding parcel”? I.e. are we supposed to survey 50’, 100’ ?’ outside the planned area?
The intent of the statement, “into established reference points, locate easements, wooded areas to show extent of growth both within the planned parcel and surrounding parcel.” was to have within a reasonable distance (50 – 100-ft) show tree or other land use. There was no intent to have the surrounding parcel surveyed. The survey, it is understood, would show related metes and bounds.
- 2) Under Paragraph 6 the Information For Vendors refers to affixing yellow caps to the requested 5/8” rebar. We assume the vendor is responsible for the purchase of these caps. If so will the example cap shown on the attached catalogue cut meet your requirements? The top of the cap will be 1” in diameter and will have 2 lines of 13 spaces available for the labeling on the cap. “Oswego County” = 13 spaces for one line.
Yes: This is the intended style/type cap.
- 3) We can appreciate the sensitivity of the negotiations that is probably associated with the purchase of new sites, but we really need an idea where the existing and proposed sites are so we can plan the survey progression and get a feel for travel distance. Attached please find a .pdf of the Oswego County Highway Map. A mere dot where the 8 existing and 9 new sites are going to be would really help. Or, maybe there is a tower coverage map out there you can forward to us. We can then place our own dots on the county map to obtain a better feel for the locations of the surveys.
The proposed sites are indeed not located. Oswego County provides the following list for your review. See the accompanying chart. Treat as confidential.
