

**LEGAL NOTICE
OSWEGO COUNTY AIRPORT
STORAGE BUILDING**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Oswego County Purchasing Department, 46 East Bridge Street, Oswego, NY 13126, until 11:00 am local time, Thursday, March 18, 2010, and there, at said office, at said time, publically opened and read aloud.

This project includes the construction of a pole barn style storage building which is approximately 52 feet x 30 feet.

The Contract Documents (consisting of the Advertisement, Proposal, Agreement, and the Specifications) and the Contract Drawings may be obtained only from the Purchasing Department, (315) 349-8307, upon deposit of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per set (check only) payable to Oswego County. Any Contract Document holder, upon returning the Contract Documents in good condition within thirty (30) days of the award of contract, or rejection of proposals, will be refunded the full amount of his/her deposit. Parties failing to conform to the above conditions within that prescribed allotted time shall forfeit their deposits as heretofore set forth and shall have no recourse against Oswego County for refunds of the Contract Documents deposit.

Each proposal must be made using the forms provided in the Contract Documents and shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the County of Oswego in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total maximum proposal price as a guarantee that the bidder will enter in to the Contract if the project is awarded to them. If upon acceptance of the bid, a bidder fails to enter into a Contract with the County of Oswego, the certified check or bid bond shall be forfeited and become the property of the County.

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes with "Bid# 09-10, Construction of Storage Building" plainly written on the outside. No bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the bid opening. The successful bidder must furnish performance and payment bonds, each in an amount at least equal to the total maximum proposal price, with a surety authorized to do business in the State of New York. The owner intends to award based on available funding with the following priorities. Priority#1=Base Bid, Priority#2=Add-on#1. Priority#3=Add-on#2. Priority#4=Add-on#3.

Bidders are not to include in the bid, sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of counties or cities on materials, equipment, and supplies to be incorporated into the project. Minimum wage rates shall be determined by the New York State Department of Labor.

The General Municipal Law of the State of New York requires that bidders certify that, under penalty of perjury, that bids have been prepared without collusion with other bidders, subcontractors, suppliers, etc. A certification is included with the bid proposal that each bidder must sign.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the proposal, and to reject any and all proposals.
