#### DRAWINGS:

##### **A-101 Detail #16 GUARD RAIL POST BOOT FLASH DETAIL**

This detail indicates a manufactured Flashing Boot. A field installed EPDM Flashing is an acceptable alternative if installed per the roof manufacturer's specifications.

##### **A-101 ROOF PLAN**

The Main Roof had indicated a minimum slope of 1/8" per 12". The original construction drawings for the building indicate that the structural steel is sloped to the drains. We have not field verified this condition (See attached Roof Framing Plan 8/12/86). The sloped steel framing would minimize the need for tapered insulation.

The Low Canopy roof deck is assumed to be flat requiring tapered insulation to drain.
